Playing the Course: Blue Tees

This Jack Nicklaus design will challenge golfers to the right level; not too long or difficult but no pushover either. One of its main charms, apart from the scenery, is that it gives players the feeling that they have the place all to themselves as none of the holes lie adjacent to each other. There are plenty of hazards to focus the mind, although, as with most Nicklaus designs, it is harsh but fair; playing a truly bad shot results in punishment, but play well and the reward is sure to follow.

The 3rd, 487 yards par 5 stroke index 1, can be tricky with decisions to make, depending on how well the tee shot goes. The drive is deceptive; foliage on either side makes the landing area look narrower than it is. But, negotiate this bit, and then it's decision time. The choices are: smack it on for two, or lay up on the right or left of the water running all along the left side before crossing over to the right. Going right, avoiding the water, sounds sensible, but your view of the pin may be blocked by reeds. Have a good look at the left option even though it is slightly more difficult.



The 16th, 348 yards par 4, is the signature hole here and, although short, it requires some club selection considerations before taking the plunge. It is a slight dog-leg right with water and bunkers about 200 to 220 yards off the tee on the right, which makes a very narrow landing area. So, a club to get off the tee about 190 yards is best. This avoids trouble but means a longer shot over a lake that surrounds half the green, which also has a large bunker on the left. Nothing other than a precise mid-iron will do to make sure of par.

The 18th, 411 yards par 4, stroke index 2, is a strong finishing hole. With water in front of the tee box and all the way along the left, it deserves some respect. A nasty little bunker sits right in the middle of the fairway about 200 yards from the tee, which makes a good drive a premium. A 4 or 5 iron is left into a green very well protected by a bunker and the water.

Regulations

1	Golfers are required to wear proper golf attire.
2	"Hole-In-One Golfer" will receive a certificate of Hole-In-One.
3	To avoid a cancellation fee, any cancellation notice for reservations on Saturday, Sunday, and Public Holidays must be made at least 24 hours prior to tee-off time. Otherwise, 20% of the fee will be charged to the golfer's credit card. For the promotion program, the cancellation policy is subject to each program.
4	On Saturday, Sunday, and Public Holidays, all flights require a minimum of 2 players.
5	A maximum of 5 players is allowed per flight.
6	The usage of a golf cart and caddy per player per round is compulsory.
7	Golfers wishing to play alone must tee off after 14:00 hrs.
8	Children under 10 years and junior golfers must have acknowledgment and approval from Kirimaya's Club Professional.
9	Due to weather conditions, golfers who cannot complete 9 holes are entitled to receive an 18-hole "Rain Check Certificate" on the green fee only.
10	Due to weather conditions, golfers who cannot complete 14 holes are entitled to receive a 9-hole "Rain Check Certificate" on the green fee only.
11	9-hole play is accepted from 15:00 hrs onwards and must start from Hole 1.
12	Non-golfers who wish to ride along with a golfer will be charged THB 1,000, which includes a golf cart and one caddy.
13	Food from outside is not allowed.
