



GOLF COURSE

The course ranges from 4,875 yards (ladies) to an incredible 7,115 yards (tournament); it is challenging and requires course management skills, for both short and long game. With its single-track layout, golfers feel as if they are the only ones on the entire course for a truly memorable golf experience. An easy drive from hectic Bangkok, The Kirimaya offers an instant escape from crowded city life. Here, on the edge of Khao Yai National Park, the chic elegance of contemporary living blends seamlessly with natural beauty.



PLAYING THE COURSE: BLUE TEES

This Jack Nicklaus design will challenge the golfers to the right level; not too long or difficult but no push-over either. One of its main charms, apart from the scenery, is that it gives players the feeling that they have the place all to themselves as none of the holes lie adjacent to each other. They are plenty of hazards to focus the mind although, as with most Nicklaus designs, it is harsh but fair; playing a truly bad shot results are punishments but play well and reward is sour to follow.

The 3rd 487 yards par 5 stroke index I can be tricky with decisions to make, depending how well the tee shot goes. The drive is deceptive; foliage either side makes the landing area look narrower than it is, but negotiate this bit and then its decision time. The choices are; smack it on for two, or lay up on the right or left of the water running all along the left side before crossing over to the right. Going right avoiding the water sounds sensible, but your view of the pin may be blocked by reeds. Have a good look at the left option even though it is slightly more difficult.



The 16th 348 yards par 4 is the signature hole here and although short, it requires some club selection ponderings before taking the plunge. It is a slight dog-leg right with water and bunkers about 200 to 220 yards off the tee on the right which makes a very narrow landing area so a club to get off the tee about 190 yards is best. This avoids trouble but means a longer shot over a lake that surrounds half the green which also has a large bunker on the left; nothing other than a precise mid iron will do to make sure of par.

The 18th 411 yards par 4 stroke index 2 is a strong finishing hole. With water in front of the tee box and all the way along the left, it deserves some respect. A nasty little bunker sits right in the middle of the fairway at about 200 yards from the tee which makes a good drive at a premium and with a 4 or 5 iron left into a green very well protected by a bunker and the water.

REGULATIONS

- · Golfer is required to wear proper golf attire.
- "Hole-In-One Golfer" will receive a certificate of Hole-In-One.
- In order to avoid cancellation fee, any cancellation notice for reservation on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays must be made at least 24 hours prior to T-Off time, otherwise 20% of the fee will be charged to golfer's credit card. For the promotion program, the cancellation policy is subject to each program.
- On Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays; all flights require a minimum of 2 balls.
- Maximum of 5 balls allowed per flight.
- Compulsory the usage of golf cart and caddy per ball per round.
- Course allows golfer wishing to play alone must T-Off after 14:00 hrs.

- Children under 10 years and junior golfers must have an acknowledgement and approval from Kirimaya's Club Professional.
- Due to the weather condition; golfers who cannot complete 9 holes are entitled to get 18 holes "Rain Check Certificate" on green fee only.
- Due to the weather condition; golfers who cannot complete 14 holes are entitled to get 9 holes "Rain Check Certificate" on green fee only.
- 9 Holes play accepted from 15:00 hrs. onwards and must start from Hole 1.
- Non-golfer who wish to go ride along with the golfer will be charged THB 1,000 which includes golf cart and one caddy.
- Food from outside is not allowed.
